SOCIAL CONNECTIONS GROUP Is a supportive group designed to help teens build confidence and navigate social interactions effectively within a safe environment. The group will empower high school teens to develop essential skills that will help them move forward in all areas of life.

Objectives:

- To build confidence in everyday social situations
- Learn to start and maintain conversations with peers and adults
- Practice active listening and empathy
- Learn to manage social anxiety and nervous thoughts
- Learn to express themselves clearly and respectfully
- To gain tools to develop stronger friendships and connections

Examples of Teaching Methods Used:

- Gradual exposure with low-stakes scenarios
- Success journaling for tracking weekly interactions
- Confidence building through learning positive self-talk
- Peer support, collaborating with other's in group
- Modeling, leaders and peers demonstrate conversation starters
- Role-playing within group
- Obtaining a "conversation toolbox"
